



SINGAPORE TURF CLUB MEETING PREVIEW

Saturday February 29, 2020

Racing doesn't get much better than what is on offer from Singapore on Saturday and the first leg of the Four-year-Old Challenge, the Group 3 Silver Bowl, highlights the excellent 10-race card.

At set-weights it will favour the higher rated horses and BOLD THRUSTER looks a 'monty' on paper given he is some 8.5kg better off than his nearest rated rival.

His last start win was over this trip when giving weight to most others at the race conditions of the Fortune Bowl and if he can cross (again) from the wide gate and race handy, he will be hard to pass late.

The stable mate - and recently crowned Champion 3YO for 2019 - TOP KNIGHT is the obvious danger with the Vlad Duric a definite factor given he rode BOLD THRUSTER to win at his last start.



Mike Clements saddles four horses with claims in the Silver Bowl with BOLD THRUSTER and TOP KNIGHT the picks.

But Duric and connections would be thinking ahead and TOP KNIGHT - while he can win this with best work expected late - will be better suited over the second-leg mile and no doubt his trainer Mike Clements has one eye on the Derby in July.

The race is wide open after these two, although Clements also saddles SIAM BLUE VANDA and REAL SUCCESS who have some claims and it will pay to go as wide as possible in exotics given the depth of the Group field.



Vlad Duric always has choices to make when nominations are released on a Monday afternoon and no doubt the Champion hoop took his time when choosing TOP KNIGHT over BOLD THRUSTER.



INFERNO added the Saas Fee to the Golden Horsehoe at his last start and should really win in Class 3 Company (race 7).

Larry says, "The usual suspects plus a few class-droppers make this a tough Class 5 event and a market watch is the recommended approach. JUMPIN JACK won one of these four starts back but has struggled since in Class 4; he gets a visor and back in Class 5 can return to the winner's list. RED CLAW's form is dismal but drops into Class 5 for the first time in his career; he goes best when ridden forward and can improve. HIGH STREET is a Class 5 veteran resuming after issues last start but his form prior was good enough to win this. Of the rest, RIVER SUPERSTAR is a Maiden now having third start since resuming and he could benefit from a positive ride, while SUPER TALENT had issues last start but a repeat of his previous effort would have him in the finish. Betting Strategy - JUMPIN JACK each-way."

Larry says, "Another tough race with plenty of unraced ones plus a couple of new arrivals to confuse the market. Of those we know, IN ALL HIS GLORY has placed at both outings and has been kept fresh; Michael Rodd stays on and from a good gate he gets a chance to break through. WAR PRIDE fought courageously from a wide gate to just miss last start when blinkers were added but is poorly drawn again; John Powell replaces the apprentice Zyrul and he can give a sight. ACHIEVED MORE resumes on the back of a moderate trial but he has placed at two of three outings and should get a good run throughout. PATTAYA's form is on the poly but he has speed and a good gate so is worth thought. Of the raced newcomers, YITAI LOYALTY placed at all three runs in Victoria and his trial was solid, while SHOWBOUND had moderate NSW form but his trial was OK. Of the first-starters MIRACLE FAST and LEGGENDA trialled solidly. Betting Strategy - IN ALL HIS GLORY to win."

Larry says, "Most of these don't win out of turn and those with winning form have it in Class 5. The ex-Godolphin 4YO LEATHERHEAD has battled since arriving in Singapore but is rarely far away. At his only previous attempt at 1800m, he ran fourth to Savoie at Flemington who subsequently placed at Listed and Group level; a repeat of that effort on the poly wins. MIGHTY EMPEROR struggled on turf last start but is much better on poly and will be prominent throughout. BILLY BRITAIN is a veteran but he loves this trip, wasn't far away last start and will get a good run throughout on his preferred surface. ATHLETICA's only win in Singapore was over 1600m on poly and he should improve back on the all-weather, while PAKATAN WARRIOR has good form in Class 5 and has previously placed in Class 4 at this trip. Betting Strategy - LEATHERHEAD win."

Larry says, "Another Class 5 full of journeymen. The apprentice rider of PEARL KING dropped his whip last start and the horse was only narrowly beaten; he gets Vlad Duric and only has to repeat that effort to win. ONE WORLD is another Class 5 specialist who ran on to win last start and whilst Class 5 horses rarely go back-to-back, the extra distance suits and this race lacks depth. MAGNUM FORCE hit the front before being swamped late last start; he has placed twice at this trip and should be handy from the good gate. DEE MAK MAK has a history of respiratory issues but put in a valiant effort last start and he can get in the finish. Include CLARTON STAR and the resuming EVIL SPEEDO on the back of a good trial in exotics. Betting Strategy - PEARL KING win, small saver on EVIL SPEEDO."

Larry says, "A small field of sprinters but some talented ones. The Lee Freedman-trained EXCELLING has built a good record since coming to Singapore and is in line for four on the trot. The 4YO has won his past two outings over this trip and comfortably beat MY DREAMLINER two starts back; Simon Kok stays on and is the one to beat. MY DREAMLINER has won five of eight starts, loves the poly, this trip suits and will be prominent for a long way. SKYWALK struggled over 1400m last start but his previous poly form was strong; he gives them all weight but the trip suits and he has class on his side. ZAC KASA's best form is on turf over 1200m but he races well fresh and his recent trial was strong; with Michael Rodd he can go forward and be hard to pass. Betting Strategy - EXCELLING win, saver on Zac Kasa."

Larry says, "Some very smart and progressive types head to start of this Class 4 turf sprint and two 3YO's in particular - MR MALEK and COUNT ME IN - should have a big future. MR MALEK has race fitness on his side and after a sighter on the Poly on debut, a strong maiden win was followed by a very comfortable Novice victory - both on turf. He is better than Class 4 and while he is tested against some nice types here, he looks hard to beat. COUNT ME IN is resuming after a very impressive first campaign that saw two wins and an eye-catching fourth in the Golden Horseshoe from just three starts. The juvenile form from last year has more than held up and he wins without surprising. Of the rest, SUPER SMART looks the danger. The 4YO just missed when dropping to Class 4 last start and will keep the 3YO's honest with Duric up. TRAPIO, SAMURAI EXPRESS, FLYING TOURBILLION and KIMITONARA for exotics. Betting Strategy - MR MALEK win."

Larry says, "Stars don't come round too often and racegoers will appreciate heading to the track to watch INFERNO stamp his authority on this Class 3 field. Undefeated at four career starts and a Group winner as a two and three-year-old, the son of Holy Roman Emperor looks to have the local racing world at his mercy and if he is as good as some astute judges think, he is more than up to Class 3, albeit against some handy older horses. Obviously he will be very short in the betting - and justifiable so - but it will pay to respect horses like SIAM WARRIOR and IRONSIDE who have both found winning form in this Company, while two last start winners up in grade in SURGE and STREET CRY SUCCESS also keep the fave honest. Include SO YOU TOO, CHARGER and NATIONALITY in exotics. Betting Strategy - INFERNO strong win."

Larry says, "Most Class 5 races are raffles and even more so when the race takes in two bends of the Kranji turf track. But this 2000m event does look top heavy with the four horses carrying 58kg and above the ones to be on. Which one? THE NUTTER brought some solid Class 4 to this Company last start and almost got the chocolates. He has drawn wide here but will go forward and look the winner late. JUPITER DRAGON drops in grade after a bold run in Class 4 last start over 1800m. That form should hold up here and from gate 4 with L Beuzelin to ride, he could give a sight. BLUE CHIP won last start and while back-to-back Class 5 wins are tough, he looks well suited over 2000m and probably starts favourite with Duric up. The maiden AMAZING CHOICE is also in the winning mix on recent form and go wider in exotics. Betting Strategy - JUPITER DRAGON each-way."
