



# SINGAPORE TURF CLUB MEETING PREVIEW

**Friday March 6, 2020**

An interesting eight-race card from Singapore on Friday and while there do look some races that lack depth early, some wide open affairs late will give value punters plenty to smile about.

Case in point is race 6 on the card - a Class 4 turf mile - where three last start winners will do battle with at least five more that are due.

Of the last start winners, THE WILD BUNCH has won two from his three - his most recent run winning over 1400m in Class 4 - and he will be prominent throughout over the mile, while GOD'S GIFT broke his maiden status over this trip and he looks a horse to follow.

Three horses who placed last start and are suited over the mile include GOLD CITY, MADE IN RUSSIA and RESTRAINED and all three win without surprising, while IRVING LIPSCHITZ and MATSURIBAYSHI also come off good runs and play a big part in what should be an extremely busy finish.

You could go even wider again in exotics and hopefully a cheeky tierce or quartet pays handsomely.

Elsewhere on the card, CEVALI looks a promising type and given the 3YO had excuses (heart) after a tough run in the Saas Fee at his last start, he looks better than Class 4 and should be one of the better bets on the night on the back of a very nice trial.

**RACE 1: CLASS 5 - 1600M (TURF TRACK 'C' (SC)) TIME: 18:50 PRIZE MONEY: S\$30000**

Larry says, "A very wide-open Class 5 mile to open the weekends racing and it may pay to keep an eye on the market to watch for any stable support. Stephen Gray has two runners comparatively down in the weights with MILITARY CHAIRMAN and MILLENIUM'S RULE both some show on best form. MILITARY CHAIRMAN hasn't shown much at his last couple but blinkers off in this type of race looks ideal and he may be the value pick. But the biggest Class dropper in the field is MIDDLE KINGDOM and he looks the one to beat. True, he hasn't won in Singapore and he may be better of longer, but his recent form in Class 4 should account for most of these. You can make a good case for most others including LIM'S RAY at value with John Powell up, while GOLD KINGDOM, LITTLE MASTER and ATLANTIC FOX all win on recent form without surprising. Betting Strategy - MIDDLE KINGDOM win, saver on MILITARY CHAIRMAN."

Larry says, "While we can forgive I AM THE STAR's debut flop and a couple of others should improve on their respective last starts in better company than this, EVEREST is very hard to beat on what he showed on debut. The 4YO loomed the winner with support on that occasion when running second and in this field with that experience under his belt, he is the one to be on. In saying that, he will be very short in the betting and the danger is I AM THE STAR. The mare was eased out of the race at her Singapore debut and on trial form she would win a race like this and is worth following. Nothing else appeals although SUPER PINS and HIGH VOLTAGE will find this Company easier than what they faced at their respective Singapore debuts and market best guide on that pair and most others. Betting Strategy - EVEREST, I AM THE STAR forecast."

Larry says, "Not an overly strong Class 4 Poly dash and all things being equal, CELAVI should win. The 3YO battled away late in the Saas Fee after a tough run, but did have issues (heart) and his form prior which included a Poly win on debut suggests the race and Company suits and he wins if right. The biggest danger on paper is FIRST CHOICE who is resuming after a bleeding attack but he won a similar affair to this at his start prior and he will keep CEVALI honest. You can throw a blanket over the rest with perhaps LIM'S FORCE the best of that bunch on his good recent form that included a place last start in this Company, while BEJEWELLED is super honest and could play a part from a good gate. Betting Strategy - strong win CELAVI."

Larry says, "A rare Class 5 event where we find two last start winners and another three that finished second at their respective last starts, suggesting a busy finish is on the cards. Unfortunately both last start winners - PAPERBACK TROOPER and WINNER NUMBER ONE - have drawn wide so will need to be at their best but winning form is always good form so worth another look. But TRY MAK MAK may be hardest to beat given he won two back, was close up last start and gets Vlad Duric which counts for plenty. Of the others that are due, PIONEER SEVEN hasn't won since June 2017 (in very good Company) but obviously he has found form in Class 5 and gets his chance from gate 2, while UNCLE LUCKY will probably lead and can win dropping back to his best trip. Betting Strategy - TRY MAK MAK win."

Larry says, "Another Class 4 Poly dash with no real depth and while there is no standout, TIME TO ROCK did enough last start to get back in the winners circle. The 6YO mare was not at her best before keeping the smart Mr Malek honest and with R Maia retaining the ride, she only needs to replicate that run to win. The likely favourite is the resuming LIM'S MIGHTY and he could be hardest to beat. The 5YO broke through in Singapore in a similar race to this at his last start and he would be hard to beat on that form with a solid recent trial under his belt. Nothing else wins without surprising although HERO STAR won in Class 5 last start and should be very competitive in this field, while DRONE should be thereabouts. Keep the newcomer from Argentina - TENYATTA - safe with market best guide on the back of a quiet trial. Betting Strategy - TIME TO ROCK win."

Larry says, "A wide open Class 4 mile with most horses looking due or capable of running a good race at odds. There are three last start winners in the field and while LEMON SQUASH should struggle in this Company after a slogging maiden win, GOD'S GIFT looks a handy miler and can back up his maiden win with a big run and WILD BUNCH is a tough sort who is worth following. Of those that are due, both IRVING LIPSCHITZ and GOLD CITY put in very good runs when resuming and both look ideally placed over the mile, while MADE IN RUSSIA, RESTRAINED and MATSURIBAYASHI all win without surprising on good recent form. Go wider in exotics and expect a very busy finish. Betting Strategy - MATSURIBAYASHI each-way."

Larry says, "None of these jump off the page and for many it has been a long time between drinks. The most interesting runner is STAR OF JUPITER who won a Class 3 in dominant fashion on arrival and then bled in the EW Barker. He has trialled well and is a horse that placed at Group level in Australia before arrival; if ready he will be hard to beat with 52kg from gate four. Another to watch is the Lee Freedman-trained YOU ROKK who is now third up from a break and won three times over this trip before arrival; blinkers go back on and with Munger to ride from a good gate he should be in the finish. Hardest to run down may be the consistent LIM'S DREAM who has suffered that fate at his past three outings, while MURAAHIB has been racing consistently and is well placed with 51.5kg. PASSPORT TO ROME, BE BEE and SAFEER for the exotics. Betting Strategy - STAR OF JUPITER win."

Larry says, "Another race where none win out of turn. LEADING CELLIST was caught wide and disappointed last start. Prior to that, he won two starts back with Harry Kassim and trainer David Kok has reverted to the winning formula; from gate one he can go forward and be hard to run down. YULONG GREEN has been racing consistently placing at all three starts since resuming; he is poorly drawn but has speed and with Vlad Duric will be hard to run down. RESOLUTION showed improvement and was only run down late last start; Alysha Collett stays on and he can give a sight again.
